## Goals of the project



Increase competencies and know-how of the actors in terms of cultural heritage work, digital skills, service design and business. The project pays special attention to the digital leap caused by the corona pandemic and changes in the field of cultural heritage.



Strengthen the resources of civil society to be more strongly involved in the work on sustainable development. Sustainable development and climate change mitigation are cross-cutting themes in project's training, operating models and on implementing pilot projects.



**Increase networking between actors and different administrative sectors** and create a basis for new types of projects and businesses. The project contributes to stronger integration of the region.

## Concrete Results



**New networks:** Opening up connections between different sectors and networking with local and international actors and bodies in the field of living heritage.



**Enhanced capacities**: Through a series of webinars, seminars and workshops all participants and organisations in the project will learn new skills and get new ideas on working in their field.



**New projects, products and services**: Through sharing, learning and cocreation new projects/ products/ services will be tested (2-3 innovations per country) with the support of project and local funding.



**Online platform**: The multidisciplinary resource bank of data, tools and good practices from the field of living heritage will serve other actors and countries after the project in English. It will present case studies and tools from all ten countries.



## The Main Measures of the Project

#### Four interconnected themes:

- **1. Cultural** sustainability: Inclusion, equality and diversity
- **2. Social** sustainability: Education, health, well-being
- **3. Ecological** sustainability: nature-related ICH, traditional knowledge
- **4. Economic** sustainability: livelihoods, tourism, heritage-sensitive marketing, IP protection
